



## FEE SCHEDULE 2023

### ENROLMENT PRIORITY

St Elizabeth's Catholic Primary School's enrolment priority is at the discretion of the Principal and is as follows;

- Catholic students from the Parish with a Parish Priest Reference
- Catholic students from outside the Parish with a Parish Priest Reference
- Catholic students without references
- Siblings of non-Catholic students
- Non-Catholic students from other Christian denominations
- Non-Catholic students with no Religion

### APPLICATION FORMS

The application must be returned with an Application Fee of \$25.00 and all relevant documents stipulated in the application form. The Application Fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee enrolment.

### INTERVIEW

Interviews are conducted with the Principal, both parents/guardians and the child must be present at the interview. Interviews take place the year before they are due to commence pre kindy. Parents wishing to enrol children for other year levels (years one to six) will be given an appointment within an appropriate timeframe.

### ENROLMENT DEPOSIT

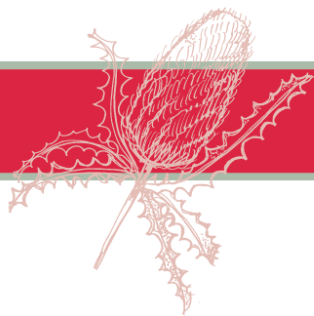
The prospective student and parents will be interviewed and if successful, a Letter of Offer will be sent. To confirm placement a \$200.00 Enrolment Deposit is payable. This deposit is deducted from your school fee account upon commencement at St Elizabeth's Catholic Primary School. However, if you do not enrol your child the bond is non-refundable.

### SIBLING DISCOUNT

The level of sibling discount is determined by Catholic Education WA.

1 <sup>st</sup> Child enrolled	0%
2 <sup>nd</sup> Child enrolled	20% of that child's tuition fee
3 <sup>rd</sup> Child enrolled	40% of that child's tuition fee
4 <sup>th</sup> Child enrolled	100% of that child's tuition fee

*All students and families are eligible for sibling discounts including families who receive automatic tuition fee discounts as holders of eligible means tested family concession cards.*

## FEE CHARGES EXPLAINED

### AMENITY FEE

An amenities fee is charged per annum, \$140.00 per student in Kindergarten through to Year Six. This fee includes; photocopying, work booklets, paints, art materials, science and mathematics kits, class resources and consumables, music resources and consumables, physical education equipment, library resources and other items required as part of the school curriculum.

### EXCURSION AND/OR INCURSION FEE

An Excursion and /or Incursion Fee is charged per annum, Kindergarten is \$50.00 per student and Pre Primary to Year Six is \$80.00 per student. This fee includes any educational and social wellbeing excursions and/or incursions, guest speakers, transport, performing arts and venue entrance fees.

### PE – SWIMMING FEE

A PE swimming fee is charged to students in Year One to Year Six; the \$150.00 per student includes entrance fees, transport and swimming instructors.

### ICT LEVY

An ICT levy is charged per annum, Kindergarten is \$76.00 per student, Pre Primary to Year Six is \$150.00 per student. The levy provides resources to enhance the digital technology curriculum with the purchase of iPad, laptops etc.

### INSURANCE

An Insurance fee maintains cover for all students at our school. We have a Student Accident Insurance Policy with Catholic Church Insurances which costs \$20.00 per student.

### BOOKLIST ITEMS

Booklists are charged per annum, Kindergarten \$130.00 per student, Pre Primary to Year Four \$127.00 per student and Year Five to Six \$107.00 per student. This fee covers items such as, but not limited to, lined paper, textbooks, handwriting books, scrapbooks, coloured paper, coloured card, A4 paper, A3 paper, lead pencils, coloured pencils, sharpeners, crayons, art liners, textas, glue sticks, blu tack, erasers, tissues, craft items, tissues, sunscreen. This fee alleviates parents having to be responsible for an annual booklist and also reduces the cost to the parent by enabling the school to bulk buy.

## THIRD PARTY PAYMENTS

Our school engages with outside organisations to provide additional services to students. The following approximate charges can be expected and will appear on your school fee statement (cost is determined by the organisations charges to the school).

- Language Screening for Kindergarten students \$85.00 per student
- Occupational Therapy Screening for Kindergarten students \$85.00 per student
- Camp for Year 5 students is \$200.00 per student
- Camp and Graduation for Year Six students \$350.00 per student

## BUILDING LEVY

A compulsory levy in all Catholic schools assists with financing the debt servicing of existing buildings and current buildings, this is applied to all families. The Building Levy is set by Catholic Education Commission WA and is 20% of the Tuition Fee.

## CATHOLIC SCHOOL PARENTS WA ASSOCIATION FEE

A CSPWA Fee is set at \$30.00 per family and supports our Catholic School Parent WA to work more closely with the school community and members of parliament.

## ACCOUNT BILLING INFORMATION

School Fees are billed at the commencement of each school year, usually in week three (3) in February. The School Fee Statement including payment options are sent to families. All school fees are to be paid by the end of October and all families must be on a payment arrangement.

We accept the following methods of payment:

### Direct Debit

Direct Debits can be made on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis direct from your nominated bank account.

### Credit Card (VISA, Mastercard)

Credit Card Payments are accepted in person in the office and on a payment arrangement basis.

### BPAY

Telephone and Internet Banking – call your bank or log into your online banking to pay your account quoting our Biller Code and your Reference Number (Situated on the bottom left of your fee statement)

## Health Care Card / Pension Card Holders Discount Scheme

This scheme assists all families who hold a current Health Care Card or Pension Card. The discount is on the Tuition Fee and the Building Levy only for Kindergarten to Year Six students. A valid card must be in the name of the biller (Parent/Guardian, not the child) and presented to the office at the commencement of the school year.

The 2023 Health Care Card Tuition fees will be

## FAMILY FEE ASSISTANCE

For families who do not qualify under the HCC Scheme, if they are experiencing financial difficulties paying their fees, assistance is available through the Principal. A confidential meeting must take place. Please make contact with the office to make an appointment.

## DEBT COLLECTION

Family accounts may be sent to Blitz Credit Management if there has been no attempt to pay, or contact made with the school. All collection fees will be passed onto the family.

## FFPOS – OVERSEAS STUDENTS

Full-fee-paying overseas students are not eligible for government funding. The below table indicates the FFPOS Tuition fee. This fee is charged on top of the Private Fees.

Kindergarten (per student)	\$4,137.00
Primary (per student)	\$15,112.00

## WITHDRAWAL OF A STUDENT

It is a condition of enrolment that ***one full term's notice should be given in writing to the Principal*** by the parent/guardian, prior to the withdrawal of a student. In default of such notice, one quarter of the annual tuition fee will be payable.
