Woolworth's Earn & Learn Rewards.

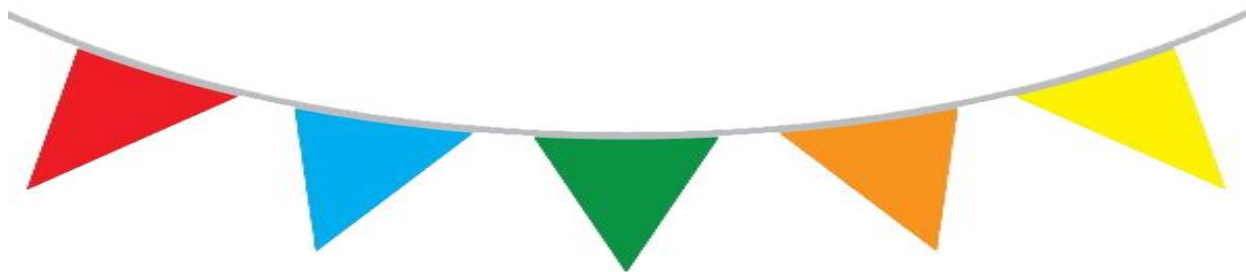
